

**ORDINANCE NO. 1031**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STORM DRAIN MASTER PLAN,  
THE STORM DRAIN ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, from time to time it is necessary to update and replace the storm drain elements of the General Plan to keep pace with development within the City and to ensure the provision of necessary public service at acceptable levels; and

**WHEREAS**, Draper City has hired a consultant to develop the Storm Drain Element of the General Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the draft document has been available for comment and review by the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission and City Council has held the necessary public hearings and finds adoption of the Storm Drain Master Plan is in the best interest of the public's health safety and general welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Findings.** This Ordinance is adopted based upon the following findings: (1) That the Storm Drain Master Plan, being the Storm Drain Element of the General Plan meets the intent, goals, and objectives of the Draper City General Plan; (2) That the proposed Storm Drain Master Plan, being the Storm Drain Element of the General Plan will provide regional drainage and flood control planning and more appropriately represent the anticipated future growth and development occurring or anticipated to occur in Draper City; (3) That the proposed Storm Drain Master Plan, being the Storm Drain Element of the General Plan will not be deleterious to the health, safety, and general welfare of the general public nor the residents of Draper City; (4) That the Storm Drain Master Plan, being the Storm Drain Element of the General Plan, shall be considered an advisory guide for growth and development of land within Draper City.

**Section 2. Adoption.** The City hereby adopts the Draper City Storm Drain Master Plan prepared by Hansen, Allen, and Luce, Inc. dated October 2012 as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.




**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
