

ORDINANCE NO. 1172

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 3-1-180(C)(1) OF THE DRAPER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS Draper City established the Draper City Historic Preservation Commission whose purpose is to assist the City in identifying, preserving, protecting, and enhancing historic buildings, sites, monuments, streetscapes and landmarks within the City deemed architecturally or historically significant; and

WHEREAS the current language in Section 3-1-180(C)(1) requires the commission to have not less than seven regular members and not more than fifteen members; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires reduce the number of required members for the Draper City Historic Preservation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Section 3-1-180(C)(1) of the Draper City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit "A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


**Section 2. Severability.** If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

## EXHIBIT A

### COMPLETE PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT

#### Section 3-1-180 Draper City Historic Preservation Commission.

##### (c) Members.

(1) Number. The Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of not less than ~~seven~~ five nor more than ~~fifteen- nine~~ members who shall have a demonstrated interest, competence or knowledge in historic preservation or architecture. To the extent available in the community, two Commission members shall be "professionals" from the disciplines of history, architecture or architectural history, as defined by the National Park Service regulations. Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, three members of the Commission may be non-residents of Draper City provided, however, such non-resident member of the Commission must own property designated on the Historic Sites List or on the Historic Landmark Register.
