

RESOLUTION NO. 15-63

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL
ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER BIKE USER FEE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Draper City has a vested interest to protect and maintain Corner Canyon and the vast biking trails within Draper City; and,

WHEREAS, the Draper City Council desires to find ways to continue the high demands of operations needed to maintain bike trails; and,

WHEREAS, The Draper City Council is desirous to make all trails and the entire Corner Canyon area accessible to all user types;, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to give residents and non-residents, at their own will and choice, the opportunity to purchase a bike user permit. Proceeds of the permit would be used to help fund maintenance on trails as well as future development related bicycles and trails.

WHEREAS, it is hoped that the bicycling “community” will recognize the assets they currently have in Corner Canyon and the unique setting it provides and be willing to voluntarily participate in the user fee program, thus generating needed revenue for the purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The City Council hereby allows and adopts a voluntary bike permit fee program, asking all bike users of Corner Canyon to voluntarily purchase a bike permit.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable..


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
