A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE PAVEMENT PRESERVATION AND RECONSTRUCTION PLAN, FUNDED WITH CLASS B&C ROAD FUNDS, FOR THE 2017 AND 2018 CONSTRUCTION SEASONS

WHEREAS, Draper City receives Class B&C Road funds for pavement maintenance; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has developed a plan to utilize the funds in order to maintain an acceptable level of service on the City's existing pavement surfaces; and

WHEREAS, the City is projecting the amount of Class B&C funding anticipated to be collected over the next two fiscal years

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Draper City Council adopts the Pavement Preservation and Reconstruction Plan identified in Exhibit A

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage



Construction Season - Spring through Fall of 2017 - \$2,750,000

- **Preventative Maintenance – Various Locations**
- **Draper Commercial (Minuteman Drive to End)**
- **Willow Springs Lane (700 East to Fort Street)**
- **Vestry Road (Highland Drive to rambling Road)**
- **Rock Mouth Lane**
- **Signal Pole Repair (200 West 13490 South)**

Construction Season - Spring through Fall of 2018 - \$2,000,000

- **Highland Drive (Minuteman to Traverse Ridge Road)**
 - **Depending on what development does, may need CIP money as well to widen**
- **300 East (11800 South to 11400 South)**
- **12900 South (1300 East to Boulter Street)**
