

RESOLUTION NO. 17-72

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MARK E. KLEINFELD TO SERVE AS THE DRAPER CITY APPEALS AND VARIANCE HEARING OFFICER AND THE EMPLOYEE APPEAL HEARING OFFICER

WHEREAS, the Draper City Municipal Code (“DCMC”) provides for an Appeals and Variance Hearing Officer to provide for just and fair treatment in the administration of the City's zoning ordinances and an Employee Appeal Hearing Officer to hear employee appeals in accordance with DCMC section 3-2-120; and

WHEREAS, Mark E. Kleinfeld has been identified through the City’s procurement process as an individual who has the experience and qualifications to serve as the hearing officer in both capacities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to appoint Mark E. Kleinfeld to serve as the Appeals and Variance Hearing Officer and the Employee Appeal Hearing Officer for the City of Draper;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Draper City Council as follows:

Section 1. Appointment. Mark E. Kleinfeld is appointed as the Appeals and Variance Hearing Officer and the Employee Appeal Hearing Officer for the City of Draper.

Section 2. Contract. The City Manager is authorized to execute contracts with Mr. Kleinfeld regarding payment for Mr. Kleinfeld’s services.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts, and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.



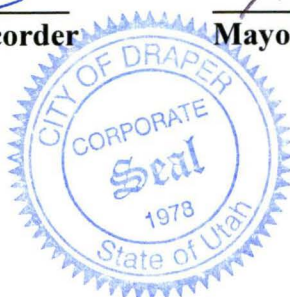
