

RESOLUTION NO. 18-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TRAVERSE RIDGE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT ADOPTING AND CERTIFYING A TAX RATE FOR THE 2018 TAXABLE YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Draper City Council (“Council”) acted as the Governing Body for the purpose of creating the Traverse Ridge Special Service District (“District”) as a Special Service District in accordance with the Utah Special Service District §17D-1-101 et seq. Utah Annotated, 1953 (the “Act”); and

WHEREAS, the Council created the Administrative Control Board in accordance with the provisions of §17D-1-101 of the Act and delegated to the Administrative Control Board the power to act as the governing authority of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Council cannot lawfully delegate to the Administrative Control Board the power to levy a tax on the property within the District and the Council retains the power and duty to levy a tax on the taxable property within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Control Board desires to have the Council, as the Governing Body of the District, establish a certified tax rate for the 2018 taxable year at a rate of 0.000540 per dollar of the taxable value on all taxable property within the District for the purpose of funding operating expenses and capital improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following Equalized Property Tax Rate is established for the Traverse Ridge Special Service District for tax year 2018 and is hereby adopted:
