

RESOLUTION NO. 18-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL WAIVING THE FEES IDENTIFIED IN THE CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE, FACILITY FEES, AND STAFF COSTS FOR THE DRAPER COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

WHEREAS, on November 19, 1996, Resolution 96-74 was adopted recognizing and encouraging the support of the Draper Community Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 96-74 declares the City previously organized and promoted community events such as Draper Days, an Easter Egg Hunt, Halloween Party, and other various community events; and

WHEREAS, the City recognized community events were time consuming and financially prohibitive and turned over the funding and organization of community events to the Draper Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the City historically contributes financially to the Draper Community Foundation, specifically for FY '18-'19, has allocated \$155,000 to the Draper Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the financial contribution, the City desires to waive special event fees, facility fees, and staff fees which are detailed in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 10-8-2 allows the City Council to waive fees for a nonprofit entity after first holding a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing and desires to support the Draper Community Foundation for community events and arts of Draper City and its residents.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL THAT:


