

RESOLUTION NO. 19-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL
REQUIRING PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND HARASSMENT TRAINING.**

WHEREAS, a recent investigation conducted by an independent risk assessor into an HR claim against Councilmember Weeks found the behavior exhibited towards an appointed City Staff member to be inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, the investigator determined that the actions taken by Councilmember Weeks placed the city at risk and in danger of potential litigation and possible damages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRAPER CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Professional Conduct and Training. Councilmember Weeks begins professional conduct and sexual harassment training with Brent Ward of Ward Lambert within a 30 day period, starting from today, Tuesday, April 9th, and to provide proof of completion to the council once finished. Ms. Weeks is to refrain from any physical contact with City Staff or representatives in the future.

Section 2. Severability Clause. If any part or provision of this resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this resolution and all provisions, clauses and words of this resolution shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


