

**RESOLUTION #12-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DRAPER CITY COUNCIL  
WITHDRAWING THE COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER BOND  
BALLOT PROPOSITION FROM THE JUNE 26, 2012 ELECTION**


**WHEREAS**, Draper City called for a special bond election on June 26, 2012 per Resolution 12-13 for the purpose of authorizing general obligation bonds not to exceed \$29,000,000 for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs of (i) acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping a community recreation center and (ii) the authorization and issuance of the Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, following public hearing and citizen and business input, the council finds it is in the general welfare of the City to withdraw the ballot proposition from the June election;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRAPER, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The community recreation center bond ballot proposition is withdrawn from the June 26, 2012 special bond election.
2. All fees incurred to date for the cost of holding a special bond election shall be paid from the general fund of the City.
